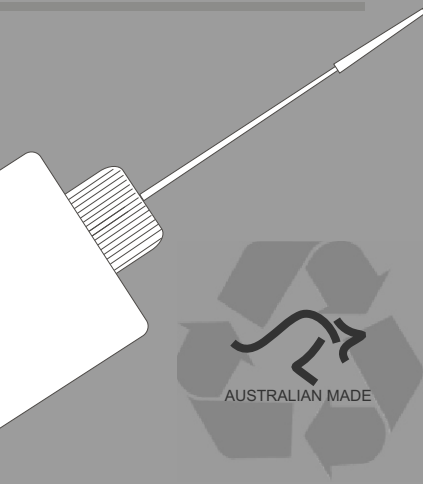

## Easyrefills kit

### Kit Contents:

- 2 x ink bottles (black)
- 1 x plastic gloves
- 1 x hand drill
- 1 x absorbent pad
- 1 x air puffer
- 1 x eye screw

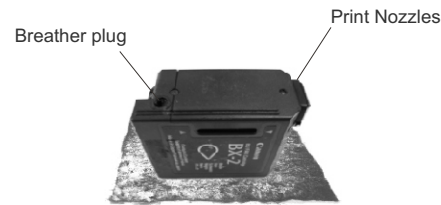
### Preparation:

- Put on the gloves supplied
- Cover your work area in newspaper in case of accidental spillage.
- Read these instructions thoroughly
- Remove the cartridge from your printer (only do this when ready to refill.)

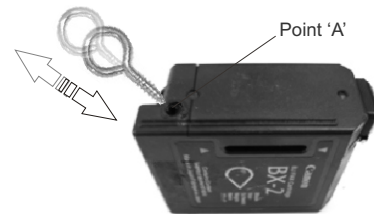
**NB:** Ink stains so we would recommend you wear old clothes or an apron when refilling.



## Preparation

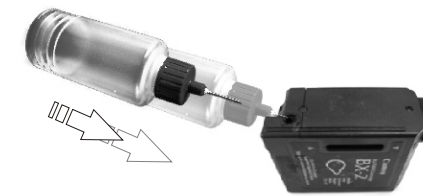


Place the cartridge on the absorbent pad provided. If a few drops of ink leak onto the pad do not worry, this is normal.



Locate the breather plug at point 'A'. Using the eye screw provided, screw into the small vent hole and pull the plug out. If you cannot remove the plug, use the drill tool provided to drill through the plug.

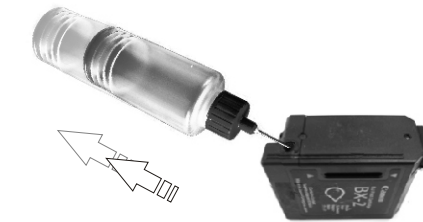
## 1 Step One



Insert the refilling needle into the filling hole. Note: You may feel a slight pressure because the cartridge contains a sponge. Continue pushing toward the inside until the refilling needle reaches the other side of the cartridge.

## 2 Step Two



S-l-o-w-l-y and gently squeeze the ink refill bottle to force ink into the cartridge. This cartridge takes approximately 20ml of ink when empty. Note: Stop refilling once ink appears at the filling hole.

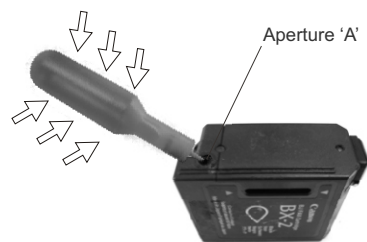

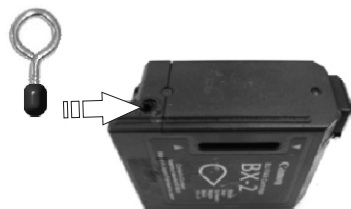

## General Information



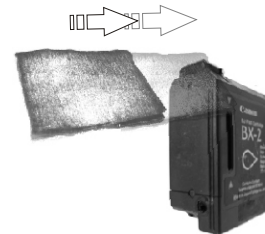
Place the tip of the air puffer into aperture 'A'. Squeeze the puffer 3 times. This will prime the cartridge by forcing ink into the printhead.

## 5 Step Five



Screw the breather plug you removed in step 2 back into the filling hole. If you did not remove the plug in step 2 ignore this step.

## 6 Step Six



Using the absorbent pad, clean any foreign materials or excess ink from the nozzles on the bottom of the cartridge. If the nozzles leak, blot with tissue until leaking stops.

## 7 Step Seven



Install the cartridge into your printer and run the head cleaning utility (see printer manual). For best results wait 20 minutes before you resume printing.

## 8 Step Eight

### Q: Cartridge will not print?

**A:** If the cartridge does not print after refilling, rest the print nozzles on a wet tissue. This will draw ink through the nozzles. Leave for 10 minutes and try printing again.

### Q: Prints with streaks through text or image?

**A:** This could mean that the print nozzles are blocked, therefore preventing ink to flow freely. To correct this problem use the printers cleaning routine. If this does not work, rest the print nozzles on a wet tissue. This will draw ink through the nozzles. Leave for 10 minutes and try printing again.

### Q: Ink stains on hands and clothes?

**A:** To clean your hands, first wash thoroughly in soap and warm water. If the stains persist, try using bathroom cleaner. It may take several washes to remove the ink. There is no real solution to ink stained clothes. However if you are using a dy cleaner, you can tell them the ink is based upon water soluble dye with ethylene glycol added.
