

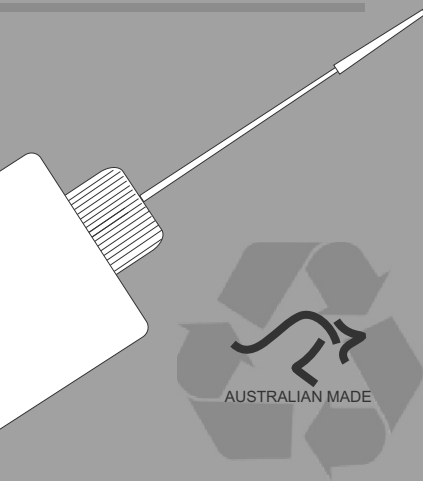

Easyrefills kit

Kit Contents:

- 3 x 40mls ink bottles (black)
- 1 x plastic gloves
- 1 x absorbent pad

Preparation:

- Put on the gloves supplied
- Cover your work area in newspaper in case of accidental spillage.
- Read these instructions thoroughly
- Remove the cartridge from your printer (only do this when ready to refill.)

NB: Ink stains so we would recommend you wear old clothes or an apron when refilling.



Preparation

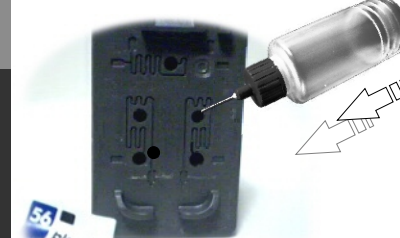


Remove cartridge from printer and place some tape over the outlet port to prevent ink drips. Peel back the sticker.



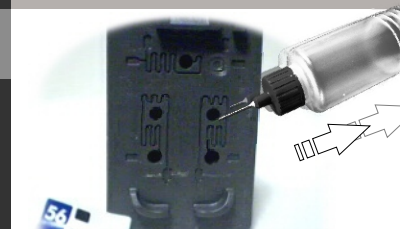
You will see 5 holes. Most of these cartridges can be filled through any hole. Exceptions are:
60 / 61XL - use **centre** hole only;
61 / 61XL / 901- use any of the **top 3** holes;
92 / 901 - use **top** hole only.

1 Step One



Insert the refilling needle through the appropriate fill hole. The other holes are just air space and your ink will be wasted. Push the needle all the way into the cartridge. Note: You will feel a slight pressure because the cartridge contains a sponge.

2 Step Two



S-l-o-w-l-y and gently squeeze the ink refill bottle to force ink into the cartridge. The reservoir will need to be filled a few times to make sure cartridge is completely filled.

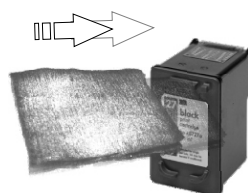

Wipe off any excess ink from around the fill hole. Remove tape from the bottom of the outlet port and replace cartridge in your printer. Leave the label off as the fill holes also act as vents to draw air in.



Allow the cartridge to sit in the printer for up to 8 hours. This will give the ink time to saturate the sponge and dissipate any air bubbles which may have formed during refilling.

Run 1-3 print head cleans and continue printing as normal.



Congratulations, by refilling your inkjet cartridges not only are you saving money but you are also helping to save our planet by helping to reduce polluting waste.

7 Step Seven

Q: Ink level Guage does not read full?

A: While your cartridge will print just like a new one, the ink level guage will not read full after a refill.

Q: Cartridge will not print or prints with streaks through text or image?

A: Check the vent or fill holes are not blocked and the cartridge has been allowed to rest for 8 hours. If air bubbles have formed during refilling they will be drawn into the printhead and stop the cartridge from printing.

If the cartridge is still printing with streaks through your image or text, this could mean that the print nozzles are blocked, thereby preventing ink from flowing freely. If you have used the printers cleaning routine already, rest the print nozzles on a wet tissue. This will draw ink through the nozzles. Leave for 10 minutes and try printing again.

Q: Ink stains on clothes?

A: Try applying white vinegar to the affected area immediately, soaking in cold water for half an hour and washing as normal.
