

- 1 x blunt needle

- Put on the gloves supplied
- Cover your work area in newspaper in case of accidental spillage.
- Read these instructions thoroughly
- Remove the cartridge from your printer (only do this when ready to refill.)

NB: Ink stains so we would recommend you wear old clothes or an apron when refilling.




Cut the label at the joint between the top and bottom cap of the cartridge. Pull the bottom cap off the cartridge.



Using the screw drill tool, screw into the centre of the rubber sealing plug in the filling hole until a firm grip is made and pull the plug out. Leave the plug on the end of the screw drill



Remove the plunger from the syringe. Put the point of the syringe over the filling hole and blow into the open end (where the plunger was). This expands the mylar bag inside the cartridge so it will accept the ink.



Carefully insert the needle of the ink bottle into the filling hole. WARNING: DO NOT allow the needle to press against the bag - even though it is blunt it can still pierce the mylar bag thereby ruining the cartridge.

S-I-o-w-I-y squeeze the ink refill bottle to force ink into the reservoir - about half the bottle should go in.



Reseal the cartridge by pushing the rubber plug in while it is still on the screw drill tool and unscrew the tool from the plug. A new plug may be used if the old one is too damaged.



Remove excess air from the bag and pump

assembly as follows: *hold cartridge at 45 angle with outlet at top;

*with plunger pushed into syringe, insert needle into outlet;



*press & release pump several times to expel air into the syringe;

*pull back plunger on syringe to remove air from the outlet hole.

Replace cap and tape and install cartridge into your printer. Run the head cleaning utility.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Before you can begin printing you will need to disable the chips on the cartridges. Simply push and hold the 'reset' button on the printer for 5 seconds. If there is no reset button, look for either a 'stop', 'cancel' or 'X'.

The manufacture date is recorded on the chip in these cartridges. It allows the cartridge to operate for two years and then the cartridge will stop working. If the cartridge has been sitting on a shelf for 6 months before you bought it, you only have 18 months left to use it and refill it as many times as you like.
