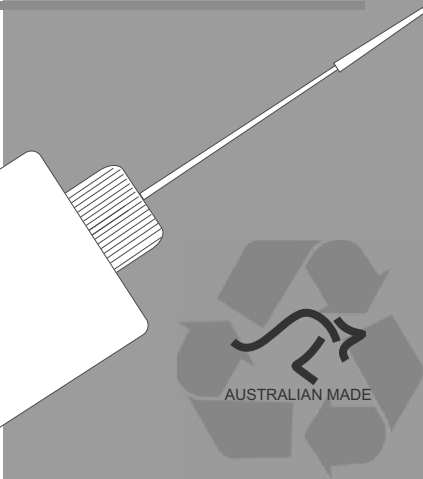

Easyrefills kit

Kit Contents:

- 5 x 40ml ink bottles (cyan, magenta, yellow, light cyan and light magenta)
- 1 x plastic gloves
- 1 x absorbent pad

Preparation:

- Put on the gloves supplied
- Cover your work area in newspaper in case of accidental spillage.
- Read these instructions thoroughly
- Remove the cartridge from your printer (only do this when ready to refill.)

NB: Ink stains so we would recommend you wear old clothes or an apron when refilling.



Preparation



Remove cartridge from printer.



Remove electronic chip from cartridge.

1 Step One



Place chip in chip resetter (sold separately) until red light turns green.

3 Step Three

2 Step Two



Under the chip is a small silicone plug. With the cartridge in the above position, remove the plug

4 Step Four

Insert the needle into the hole left by the plug and s-l-o-w-l-y and gently fill the cartridge.

5 Step Five



Replace the silicone plug and then the reset electronic chip.

6 Step Six



Replace cartridge in printer.

7 Step Seven



Congratulations, by refilling your inkjet cartridges not only are you saving money but you are also helping to save our planet by helping to reduce polluting waste.

Q: Ink stains on hands and clothes?

A: To clean your hands, first wash thoroughly in soap and warm water. If the stains persist, try using bathroom cleaner. It may take several washes to remove the ink. There is no real solution to ink stained clothes. However if you are using a dry cleaner, you can tell them the ink is based upon water soluble dye with ethylene glycol added.
